

PICTURE BOOKS @ PINEROLO



TOHBY RIDDLE is an award-winning artist and writer whose deceptively simple illustrations contain the most fascinating detail. His picture books charm children and all lovers of illustration. His beautiful books include *Unforgotten, Nobody Owns the Moon, The Royal Guest, The Greatest Gatsby* and *Milo, A Moving Story*. His latest are *Here Comes Stinkbug!* and *Yahoo Creek*. During this workshop Tohby will draw on his wide and varied experience, as an author, illustrator and editor, to provide fascinating personal, professional insights into the craft of creating picture books.

Margaret Hamilton Books, which specialised in picture books, achieved international success and a reputation for high quality books, many of them award winners. Margaret now runs Pinerolo, her children's book cottage at Blackheath in the Blue Mountains where she promotes picture books and their creators. Her first picture book *B is for Bedtime*, illustrated by Anna Pignataro, was published by Little Hare in 2014 and was a CBCA 2015 Notable Australian Children's Book. Her second, *Counting Through the Day* was published in 2016 and a third is in preparation. Original artwork for both these books and others is for sale at Pinerolo.
